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Northern Europe. 13th century. Last pagan settlement near the Baltic Sea. The evil and cynical warrior crusader Max von Buxhoveden is trying to destroy the pagan beliefs of the people by spreading lies and fostering dissent. Old king of the last free pagan lands is on his deathbed and without an heir to take his place. Max wants to take over the throne and reign over old king's tribe. Unexpectedly, with his dying breath the King passes on his ring to his nephew Namejs. Namejs, who grew up amongst pagan priests and studied ancient wisdoms, now has to defend his people. Will he be able to unravel the secret of the Ring and gain its power?

"The Pagan King" is British -Latvia film based on a 13th century legend and tells the story of a young king Namejs who must win the confidence of his people in order to defend their freedom. The Film is not a direct reconstruction of historical events, but rather a legend full of adventures. "Freedom is not just a good feeling, it's important, sometimes cruel and hard choice, endurance, courage and self-esteem", says Mr. Aigars Grauba, Director of the Film.

The film stars are international team - Edvin Endre (Sweden), James Bloor (Great Britain), Aistė Diržiūtė (Lithuania) and famous Latvian actors. National Premiere of the Film took place on January 17, 2018 in Riga (Latvia), but International Premiere was on May 9, 2018 in Vilnius (Lithuania).

Film is in English with subtitles in Latvian and Russian (110 min). Director of the Film Mr. Aigars Grauba will take part in the premier of the Film in Minsk.

"The Pagan King" will be shown on Thursday, December 6 at 18.00 in the Cinema "Silver Screen", hall Nr.5 (Dana Mall, 3rd Floor, улица Петра Мстиславца 11). Cinema Silver screen is the Latvian - Belarussian joint venture successfully operating in Belarus.
